WEB FUND COMMITTEE

The overall mission of the Lincoln County “WEB” Fund Committee ("Committee") is to develop and maintain the interests of the citizens of Lincoln County by and through the continuation and expansion of economic and social development of Lincoln County.

The WEB fund was created to serve the communities of Lincoln County by and through the development of a plan for this county and ensuring that funds are available to support the interests, educational and social betterment and overall safety of the individuals who reside in Lincoln County as well as support local county government.

All WEB fund endeavors adhere to a contribution policy, which is designed to create an effective giving policy so as to support as many qualified requests as possible.

Preference is given to requests that demonstrate the following criteria:

- Identifies a distinct need or problem in a focus area of the WEB Fund;
- Proposes a resourceful approach to address the need or problem;
- Demonstrates the ability to accomplish the measurable result during a set timeframe.

Requests for support are accepted on a continuous basis, and reviewed at least quarterly. However, due to budget or time constraints, requests may be declined or deferred to the following year. Although special meetings may be called in some instances, requests with time constraints should allow ample time for the review process.

To apply for a contribution, the Contribution Application Summary form must be filled out in its entirety and will be submitted to the WEB Committee through the office of Economic Development. Additional information can be attached as needed.

All requests for WEB fund contributions are reviewed by the Committee, who evaluate each request and/or proposal based on, but not limited to, the above guidelines. Applicants who do not meet funding guidelines and/or proposals without sufficient information will normally be declined.
